1 September 2008	11 years	U13 Stage 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 9 Players on the field</li> <li>• 8 balls max per over, last over 6 legal</li> <li>• 20 overs per innings – 3 hours per day</li> <li>• 18m (U13) and 20m (U15) pitch stump to stump</li> <li>• 142g leather Kookaburra ball</li> <li>• 35m/40m boundary, 10m field restriction</li> <li>• Bowl both ends - 13 10/10, U15 alternate</li> <li>• Batting 20 balls each then retire</li> <li>• Out you are out</li> <li>• All players are to bowl (each Wicket-Keeper is to bowl one over each)</li> <li>• Statistics kept, competition with finals</li> </ul>
